Southwestern Pennsylvania University Presidents Unite Against Campus Sexual Assault

- Leaders to report on renewed regional efforts to keep students safe -

WHAT:

On Monday, Sept. 11, college and university presidents, the district attorney's office, elected officials, violence prevention advocates, student activists and community partners will report on the region's efforts to prevent campus sexual violence. Leaders will also encourage students to report and seek assistance through available resources.

One in five female undergraduates and one in 14 male undergraduates have reported experiencing sexual assault while in college, according to the <u>Department of Justice</u>.
